Other Excess Emissions Report – Request for Continued Operation

R1010

Instructions: Pursuant to the Excess Emission Rules ([LRAPA 36-020](#)), Title V sources must submit this Excess Emissions Report within 8 hours of the beginning of the excess emissions event to request continued operation if not ceasing operation immediately and excess emissions event is expected to continue beyond 8 hours. This is in addition to the notification required. The owner or operator must report excess emissions under LRAPA 36-025 within 5 days of the date of the event (Title V Excess Emissions Notification Form R1007). Complete one form for each excess emissions event and submit it to the LRAPA office identified in the permit by email or facsimile.

An upset log must also be kept of all planned and unplanned excess emissions. A summary of the upset log must be submitted to LRAPA along with the Semi-Annual and Annual Report.
