spaces for employees, 976 fleet vehicle parking spaces, and 13 mechanical fleet

storage for a new e-commerce facility

ISCP

This ISCP is hereby issued in accordance with title 20 of LRAPA's Rules and Regulations to approve the construction of 368 associate (personal) parking spaces, 976 fleet vehicle parking spaces, and 13 mechanical fleet storage to the new e-commerce facility at Map 17-04-05-00, Tax Lot 00400 with the following conditions:

- Until this permit is modified or revoked E-Commerce Facility is permitted to construct and operate the indirect source parking facility cited above. The requirements, limitations, and conditions of this permit do not relieve the permittee from complying with all other rules and standards of LRAPA.
- The construction of the 368 associate parking spaces, 976 fleet vehicle parking spaces, and 13
 mechanical fleet storage must be in conformance with approved plans and specifications listed
 in the applications. No changes or deviations are allowed without prior written approval of
 LRAPA.
- The permittee shall ensure that combustion engine vehicles do not exceed the following thresholds:
 - a. Maximum 1000 total combustion engine vehicle spaces (fleet + associate) available at any time; and
 - b. Implementation of electric vehicle (EV) fleet targets: 25% (Year 1), 40% (Year 5), 70% (Year 10).
- 4. If the targets in Condition 3 are not met, the permittee must submit a corrective action plan to LRAPA within three (3) months of not meeting EV fleet targets.
- 5. The permittee must maintain records documenting fleet vehicle types (combustion vs. electric) and shall make these records available to LRAPA upon request. Records shall be retained for a period of at least five (5) years.
- 6. In accordance with title 48 of LRAPA's Rules and Regulations, E-Commerce Facility must take reasonable precautions to prevent particulate matter from becoming airborne.
- 7. If construction of the facility approved by this permit has not been completed within 15 months



after the issuance date of this permit, the permittee shall submit reports of construction progress to LRAPA. Such reports shall be submitted 15 months after the issuance date of this permit and shall be submitted thereafter annually on the anniversary date of the permit until such time as the permitted construction is completed and the Notice Completion Indirect Source form has been submitted to LRAPA. Failure to comply with this condition may constitute justification for revocation of this permit.

8. A notice of completion form, number ICSP-Ecommerce-2025 shall be completed and submitted to LRAPA following construction and prior to operation of this facility.
